

# MY DONATION TO THE HISTORIC DIVING BELL PROJECT

The purpose of preserving, protecting and displaying the Chestatee River Diving Bell is to assure that this valuable piece of gold mining history is not lost. The Chestatee River Diving Bell has received international recognition as the only known surviving diving bell from this era, and the earliest surviving example of sub-marine technology. The diving bell was designed as a vehicle to hold men in dry safety under water on the Chestatee River bed for the purpose of mining gold. It was donated to the City by the Reynolds Community of Achasta. All transportation, restoration and preparation of the Diving Bell for display has been donated by Mike and Lynn Cottrell.
